The Trustees may accept any donation, grant or contribution or loan in cash or in kind from any person, firm, company, corporation, association, institution or Trust either government or private, national or international, the Settler or the Trustees or any of them for the further advancement of the objects of the Trust or any one of more of them upon such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and which are not inconsistent with the objects of the Trust.
- III. The Trustees may also take over the management of any other Charitable or Public Trusts / Institutions / Organizations with the final consent of Settler on such terms as they think fit and may manage such institutions.

7. APPLICATION OF TRUST FUND :

- a. The Trustees shall from time to time after meeting the expenses of any incidental to the management of the Trust properties and of Trust decide the particular objects or objects for which the income or Corpus of the Trust fund or properties for the time being be available shall be applied.
- b. If the income of the Trust property in a particular year if not fully utilized the unexpected income subject to the applicable provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 shall carried over to the year or years and spent in such subsequent year or years for the advancement of any of the object of the Trust.



- c. The Trustees shall be at liberty to sell such portion of the movable or immovable properties forming part of the Trust Estate either by public auction or any private contract on the final decision taken by the Settler a such price or prices and such terms and conditions relating to title or otherwise in all respect as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and to rescind or vary and contract for the sale thereof and resell the same without being answerable for any loss occasioned thereby and to execute all conveyances of other assurance and to pass valid and effectual receipts and discharge for all works.
- d. The Trustees may pay all charges and out goings payable in respect of any immovable property for the time being forming part of the Trust Fund and may carry out repairs required to be done to the same and keep the same insured against risks or damages by fire and may insure all other costs, damages and expenses incidental to the administration and management of the Trust Estate and properties for the time belonging to the Trust as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- e. The Trustees may manage or supervise the management of any land, hereditament and premise for the time being comprised in the Trust Estate or any part thereof with power to erect, pull down, rebuilt, add to alter or repair or renovate the houses and other buildings, built drains and construct roads, fences, otherwise to improve and develop and to cultivate or cause to be cultivated all or any of the lands / and hereditaments and premises and to insure houses and buildings against loss or damage by fire and or otherwise risks or to be make leases, make allowances and rearrangements with tenants, agriculturist and generally to deal with the said loans, hereditaments and premises as they may deem fit in their absolute discretion with the final consent of the Settler.
- f. The Trustees may demise the immovable property for the time being and from time to time belonging to the Trust either from year to year of or for any fixed term or any term of years or on monthly tenancies at such rent and subject to such covenants accept surrenders of lease and tenancies and generally manage the same in such way as they think proper.
- g. The Trustees shall be entitled at their discretion from time to time to start, discontinue, abolish any charity or charitable institution, to impose any condition or conditions to any subscription or donation made by them and to earmark any portion of the Trust property or income for any particular object or objects with the final consent of the Settler.



8. ACCOUNTS :

- i. The financial year of the Trust shall be from 1st April to 31st March.
- ii. The accounts of the Trust or Institution(s) or Programme(s) run by the Trust shall be audited yearly by a qualified Auditor or a Chartered Accountant to be appointed by the Board of Trustees and the fee for Auditor / Chartered Account, if paid, shall be a part of outgoing amounts from the Trust Funds.
- iii. The Trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all money received and spent and of all matters in respect thereof in course of management of Trust properties or in relation to the carrying out of the objects and purposes of the Trust as well as of all the assets, credits and effects of the Trust properties.
- iv. The Trustees shall keep an account or accounts with any bank or banks and shall give all appropriate instructions to the banker or bankers concerning the operation of such account or accounts and shall be authorized by appropriate resolution. The Trust account or accounts can be operated by the Managing Trustee independently or jointly with other Trustees as per the resolution passed by the Board of Trustees.
- v. Managing Trustee may open 'Sub-Bank Account' with its main bank account. The Trust may allow two Trustees from the Board of Trustees to operate the 'Sub-Bank Account' on behalf of Trust. For that, a resolution copy of Trust or a letter from Managing Trustee and a resolution from the Board of Trustees are needed.
- vi. The receipt granted by the Trustees or any one or more of them for any money, stocks, funds, share, securities or investments paid, delivered or transferred to them in exercise of the Trust or power thereof shall effectually release and discharge the person or persons paying delivering or transferring the same there from seeing or from being bound to seek the application there of being answerable for the loss or misapplication thereof.
- vii. The Trustees may reimburse themselves and pay discharge out of the Trust fund all expenses incurred by them in or about the execution of the Trust or any for their dues under these presents including travelling expenses but will not be entitled to any remuneration.

9. NUMBER OF TRUSTEES:

The number of Trustees including the Author of the Trust shall not be less than two and not more than twenty one persons. The Board of Trustees shall nominate and invite person/persons to be the other trustees for such period, as they may deem fit and proper.

ADDITIONAL TRUSTEES:

The Managing Trustee for the time being will be at liberty to appoint "Additional Trustee" within in the number mentioned above for such period or on such terms as to retirement and reappointment as the Trustees for the time being consider proper.



10. TERM OF OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES:

- i. These Trustees shall hold office for such duration as may be specified by the Board of Trustees.
- ii. Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.

11. PRESIDENT:

There shall be a President for the administration of this trust, nominated by the board of Trustees, who shall be one amongst trustees as specified in paragraph (9) above for such period, in such manner as may be specified in this behalf.

12. MANAGING TRUSTEE:

- I. The Managing Trustee shall arrange for the maintenance of correct and proper accounts of receipts and disbursements, the liabilities incurred and assets acquired by the Trust.
- II. The Managing Trustee shall have the custody and control of the documents of title to the properties of the Trust, accounts and all other documents related to the Trust. The same is to be opened to view by any Trustee on reasonable notice during office hours of the Trust Office.
- III. Managing Trustee shall be the "Chief Executive Officer (CEO)" of the Board of Trustees and as such he shall have power and authority for and on behalf of the Board of Trustees.
- IV. To carry out the resolutions of the Board of Trustees.
- V. To sign all papers, receipts and documents.
- VI. To pay money due by the Trust and demand and receive the receipts thereof.
- VII. To demand and receive money due to the Trust and issue receipt for the money so received.
- VIII. To open and operate bank account or accounts in the name of the Trust and projects independently or jointly with other trustees as the Board of Trustees decide.
- IX. To make, draw, endorse, accept, sign, negotiate or transfer cheque, promissory notes, hundies, bills of exchange, bills of lading, railway receipts and other negotiable or transferable instruments, government securities or other securities.
- X. With the approval of the Commissioner / Director of Income tax to lease out for a period not exceeding three years at a time, lands and properties of the Trust which are ordinarily leased out if there is a statutory or government department requirement of a longer period of lease, the lease may be for a longer period as per such requirement and on specific resolution of the Board of Trustees.
- XI. To initiate, prosecute, defend, compromise, refer to arbitration and/or abandon legal proceedings or disputes and to sign all papers in connection therewith.
- XII. To appoint, employ, remunerate, remove, suspend, discharge, dismiss, re-employ, replace, transfer and accept resignations of staff and workers permanently or temporarily.
- XIII. To call for the meeting or meetings of the Board and others.
- XIV. To execute all document on behalf the Board of Trustees
- XV. Managing trust may appoint secretary & other posts, and assign the work as and when needed.



13. TREASURER:

The Treasurer will prepare Annual Budget, monthly and yearly expenditure statements get the expenditure audited by auditor duly appointed by the Board of Trustees and place them before the Board of Trustees for approval. The Treasurer is responsible to maintain cash book and prepare vouchers for the payments made and prepare monthly and yearly statements of revenue and expenditure, as well as, the register of assets of the Trust and place them before the Board of Trustees for their approval. The Treasurer is responsible for safe custody of cash, bonds, securities etc. of the Trust.

14. VACANCIES:

Any vacancy among the Members of the Board of Trustees may be filled by the Trustees as specified in paragraph (9) above or their successors and they shall hold office for such duration as may be specified by the Board of Trustees.

15. TERMINATION OF OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES:

Trustee shall cease to hold office:

- (i) if he / she dies.
- (ii) if he / she resigns.
- (iii) if he / she is adjudged insolvent or found guilty of an offence involving moral turpitude.
- (iv) if he / she is found to have acted against the interest of the Trust.
- (v) if it is unanimously decided by the Trustees specified in paragraph (8) above that his continuation in the Office is against the interest of the Trust.
- (vi) upon expiry of the period up to which the Board of trustees have nominated the trustee.
- (vii) if he / she without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Board of Trustees or for one calendar year, whichever is longer.
- (viii) If he/ she is minor.
- (ix) If he / she is of unsound mind.

16. MEETING AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUSTEES:

- I. The Trustees shall ordinarily meet once in every calendar year or as often as may be necessary for the satisfactory conduct of the affairs of the Trust.
- II. Two Trustees at a meeting shall form a quorum for any meeting of the Trustees with the Settler
- III. All meeting of the Trust shall be held at such place and such time as the Chairperson and Managing Trustee of the Trust may decide from time to time.
- IV. A Trustee who is unable to be present at a meeting of the Trustees may send his / her views on the agenda in writing and such expression of opinion shall be taken to be top his / her vote on the matter concerned.
- V. A Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of a majority of The Trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.
- VI. All proceedings and questions and matters arising at the meeting of the Trustees shall be decided by a majority of votes and in case of equality of votes, the Chairperson shall have a second or casting vote provided however that notwithstanding anything herein stated no question dealing with, the disposal

of the Corpus of any of the Trust properties and / or investment out of the Trust Corpus shall be decided except with the consent of the Chairperson and Managing Trustee of the Trust.

- VII. In case of difference of opinion between the Trustees, the opinion of the majority shall prevail.
- VIII. The minutes of the proceedings at every meeting of the Trustees shall be entered in book to be kept for the purpose and signed by the Chairperson of such meeting or of the following meeting when they are read over and shall when so entered and signed be conclusive evidence of the business and other matters transacted at such meeting.
- IX. The Board of Trustees may be a unanimous vote of all Trustees for the time being except the Trustees proposed to be removed and Trustees permanent or otherwise from Office after finding the Trustees proposed to be removed, guilty or serious misconduct in relation to or concerning the Trust Estate or Trust affairs and after arriving at a definite conclusion that for the reason to be recorded in writing, the continuance of the Trustees proposed to be removed as Trustees as those present was desirable keeping to the objects of the Trust in view and other related or connected matters provided however that no conclusion of such guilt shall be agreeable at without giving to the Trustees proposed to be removed a full and fair opportunity of explaining his / her removal and the decision of the charges leveled against his/her removal and the decision of the Board of Trustees shall be final and binding and shall not be called in question anywhere.
- X. The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of Trustees.

17. NOTICE:

15 days notice shall ordinarily be given in writing for a meeting of Board of Trustees.

18. QUORUM:

The Quorum for the Meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be two third numbers quorum is required for a meeting adjourning for want of Quorum. A minute book shall be kept by the Managing Trustee. Minutes of entry into the office of every new Trustee and of all proceedings of the meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be entered in the minute book and shall be signed by the Chairperson of the Meeting.

19. VOTING:

Decisions of the Board of Trustees may be made at a meeting or by circulation of papers to them. Normal matters of routine nature may be circulated and decision obtained. The important matters are to be decided at the meeting. All matters arising for disposal shall be decided by a majority of the Board of Trustees present at the Meeting. The President of the Board of Trustees shall have a casting vote in the event of equality of votes, in addition to his own.



20. POWERS, FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE TRUSTEES:

- I. All property of the Trust i.e. movable or immovable or of any other kind, shall vest in Trust, the Trustees shall manage the whole property and affairs of the Trust and shall have all powers, duties and functions necessary proper and incidental to the promotion and carrying out of the objects of the Trust.
- II. In particular and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing the Trustees shall for the purposes of this Trust have the following powers, duties and functions:
- III. To acquire by Gift, Grant, Purchase, Exchange, Lease, or otherwise, lands, buildings, or other immovable properties and also any Movable Property.
- IV. To construct and maintain buildings, to alter, to demolish or improve them and equip them suitably.
- V. To accept gifts, donations, endowments and contributions for the Trust and shall be treated as the income of the Trust.
- VI. To raise loans, to receive money, securities or other movable property on behalf of the Trust.
- VII. To accept any Trust, Trust Fund or endowment so long as the provisions of such Trust or endowments are in accordance with the objects of this Trust.
- VIII. To award scholarship and make donations calculated to promote the objects of the Trust.
- IX. To enter into contracts, or engagements on behalf of the Trust.
- X. To consider such proposals submitted by Sub-committee appointed by this Trust and allocate such funds if necessary as deemed necessary for the implementation of the programmes.
- XI. To make, sign and execute all such documents instruments, as may be necessary or proper for carrying on the management of the properties and affairs of the Trust
- XII. To invest such money and such funds of the Trust and to vary the investment as and when it may seem necessary or proper provided that such investments shall be made only upon immovable properties or upon securities as the Board of Trustees may deem fit, under section 20 of the Indian Trust Act, 1882
- XIII. To invest the Trust fund either in the purpose of mortgage of immovable property or in shares, stock of debentures of other securities and investment of in deposits with of loans to any Company, Bank and Firm of any other person and to alter, vary or transpose such investments from time to time at the discretion of the Trustees.
- XIV. To let out, demise any immovable property comprised in the Trust fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit.
- XV. To appoint Committee/Committees of management for such terms and with such powers as may be specified from time to time, for carrying on the routine management of the affairs of the Trust.



- XVI. To appoint Director(s), Executive Director(s), Deputy Director(s), Assistant Director (s), Regional Director(s), Coordinator(s), Consultant(s), Counselor(s), Faculties, Scientists, Doctors / Health Consultant(s), Nurses, Administrative staff, HR, Finance, Marketing, Operation related professionals and other employees on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may deem fit for carrying out the work of the Trust and exercise control all such employees including the power of suspension, dismissal and removal.
- XVII. To delegate to the Managing Trustee or any appointed committee such powers, duties and functions as are vested in the Trustees.
- XVIII. To frame Bye-Laws and such other regulations as are required for achieving its objectives.
- XIX. To appoint constituted Attorneys of Agents and to delegate to such Attorneys or Agents all or any of the powers vested on them under the presents and from time to time remove such Attorneys or Agents and to appoint other or others in his / her or their place.
- XX. To adjust, settle, compromise , compound and refer to Arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust fund.
- XXI. To join, cooperate or amalgamate this Trust with other or others having kindred or allied objects upon such terms and conditions as the Trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this Trust.
- XXII. To give aid by donations out of the income of the Corpus of the Trust fund or otherwise to different Charitable Institutions, Societies, Organizations or Trusts in India and abroad which may have been established or which may hereafter be establish for the like charitable purposes mention in these presents or any them to enable such Institutions, Societies, Organizations or Trust to start, maintain or carry out such charitable objects.
- XXIII. To settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings, disputes, claim, demand or things as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- XXIV. To borrow moneys either on the security of any property compromise in the Trust fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of the presents and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- XXV. To apply to Government, Public Bodies, Urban, Local Municipal, District and other bodies, Corporations, Companies or persons for and to accept, grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government department, public and other bodies, Corporations , Companies or persons, scheme or other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to confirm to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.



- XXVI. To take over or amalgamate or sign MOU, collaborate with any other Charitable Trust, Society, Association or Institution, agencies Government or non-Government with similar objects.
- XXVII. To establish, promote, manage, organize or maintain or to assist in establishing, promoting, managing , organizing or maintaining any branch of the Trust or any other Trust or its branches with objects similar to those of this Trust and to promote or carry on the affiliation or amalgamation of such other Trust with this Trust.
- XXVIII. To take over, acquire, manage, control, aid any existing institutions having objects either wholly or impart similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient to purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property , assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the Trust, Societies, Institutions or Associations with this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- XXIX. To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the Trust, Societies, Institutions or Associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- XXX. The Trustees shall be accounted only for such moneys, stocks, shares and funds as shall actually come into their hands and a Trustee shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts or omission or commission of the other Trust, nor of any banker or other persons with whom the Trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or kept.
- XXXI. Out of the income of the trust property, the Trustees shall be entitled to spend or incur the following expenses namely
- XXXII. All rates, taxes, assessments, dues and duties if any payable to the government to any municipal or other public bodies in respect thereof or any part thereof.
- XXXIII. The premium for the insurance of the buildings or any other insurable property movable
- XXXIV. or immovable for the time being forming part of the Trust property.
- XXXV. The costs of ordinary repairs and for providing any amenities to the buildings for the time being forming part of the Trust property.
- XXXVI. The cost of making such additions/alterations or improvements to or in the buildings forming part of the Trust property, as the Trustees shall think fit.
- XXXVII. Wages and salaries of any manager, supervisor, accountant, clerk, servant or other
- XXXVIII. employees employed by the Trustees in the carrying out of this Trust.
- XXXIX. Cost and expenses of keeping the Trust property in good condition.
- XL. Cost and expenses for installing and renovating the electrical and other installations in the building for the time being forming part of the Trust property.
- XLI. The architect's fee and legal charges and fee payable to other professionals engaged in
- XLII. the course of administration of the Trust.



XLIII. All other costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the management and administration of the Trust property in accordance with the objects and purposes hereof or which may be incidental thereto. After deducting the costs charges and expenses incurred by the Trustee's as aforesaid out of the total gross income received by them from the Trust property the balance that is the net income will be utilized for the objects of the Trust as decided by the board of Trustees.

21. APPLICATION OF THE PROPERTIES OF THE TRUST:

The properties and funds of the Trust shall be applied only for the purpose of the Trust and for the due administration of its business affairs and properties provided however that this shall not preclude payment of any remuneration or allowance or giving of residential accommodation or any perquisites to any Trustee in connection with the work carried out by him/her for the purpose of the Trust.

22. DEFECTS OF PROCEDURE IMMATERIAL:

No act of Trustees shall be invalidated by reason only of any vacancy in the Board of Trustees or any irregularity in the proceedings of the Board of Trustees or any Committee thereof.

23. AMENDMENTS OF THE TRUST DEED:

- I. While this Trust shall be irrevocable, the Managing Trustee may amend this Trust Deed at any time as they see fit provided each amendment is passed with a majority of the Board of Trustees.
- II. If any alteration or amendment is necessary, the same shall be affected through supplementary deed/deeds with the prior approval of the Commissioner / Director of Income Tax and these shall be read together with the main Trust deed.
- III. An amendment made to this Trust Deed will be carried out only with the prior approval of the Commissioner / Director of Income Tax or any other competent Income Tax Authorities as the case may be.

24. INDEMNITY:

The Board of Trustees shall be indemnified for any act done by them in good faith in the course of the administration of the Trust.




24. DISSOLUTION:


In the event of dissolution of winding up of the Trust, the assets of the Trust remaining on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstance be distributed among the Trustees, but the same shall transferred to other Trust, Society, Association or Institution whose objects are similar to those of this Trust.

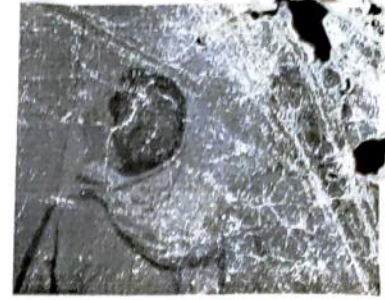
